

B2 ENGLISH TEST

(ADVANCED AUTOMOTIVE ENGINEERING)

The test

The purpose of the B2 computerised English test is to evaluate the candidates' ability to communicate in English. It tests language usage along with reading and listening comprehension. 40 minutes is the duration of the test and 60% of correct answers is its cut-score.

Who can sit the test?

The test is aimed at those students intending to apply for the Advanced Automotive Engineering course.

Only UNIMORE students and Alumni provided of UNIMORE username and password can sit the test.

Candidates failing the test can retake it on another date, if any.

How to prepare for the test

As there are no courses in preparation to the test, candidates are required to do some self-study. The Common European Framework of Reference B2 level corresponds to the Cambridge 'First Certificate in English' exam, so any material specific for the preparation of this certificate is a good choice.
