B2 ENGLISH TEST - JULY 2020

(ADVANCED AUTOMOTIVE ENGINEERING, ELECTRONICS ENGINEERING)

The test

The purpose of the B2 computerised English test is to evaluate the candidates' ability to communicate in English. It tests language usage along with reading and listening comprehension.

The test lasts 45 minutes and 60% of correct answers is its cut-score.

Who can sit the test?

The test is aimed at those students intending to apply for either the Advanced Automotive Engineering or the Electronics Engineering course.

Only UNIMORE students and Alumni provided of UNIMORE username and password can sit the test.

Candidates failing the test can retake it on another date, if available.
